## REFERRAL PROCEDURE

- ◆ People who attend day care can live in either Norfolk or Suffolk.
- ◆ Most of our referrals come via a social worker.
- ◆ People can refer themselves and self fund.
- ◆ All our new referrals are assessed in their homes prior to attending day care. We welcome anyone who would like to look around the department prior to attending.

We work very closely with social workers, GPs, district nurses and home care agencies to maintain a high level of service and continuity of care.

3 monthly reviews are carried out to ensure changing needs are met.

If you are interested in attending day care please contact the centre. For funding advice and arrangements ask your GP or social worker. Alternatively our staff will be happy to assist you with your enquiry.

## INTRODUCTION

The 'Day Treatment and Therapy Centre' was built in May 2004. It is situated in the well maintained grounds behind All Hallows Hospital, and blends in well with the hospitals architecture.



The centre is open 7 days a week providing Day Care from 9.30am to 3.30pm for up to 24 people a day. It provides a range of services designed to deliver social stimulus and a broad base of care that supports care in the community. Palliative day care is also available every Monday.

The Centre is very well equipped with aids for less able and dependent people. The nursing team has specialised training and skills to adapt to each persons individual needs

The centre has a purposely adapted minibus to transport local people to and from home. Free transport can be provided within a 5 mile radius of the centre, but is subject to availability.
